**COM FABRIC IMPORTATION DUTIES AMOUNT MUST BE PAID AT THE MOMENT OF THE FABRIC IMPORTATION.**

Effective June 4, 2025, U.S. President Donald Trump has decreed an additional 25% tariff on imports of aluminum and steel materials.

**The 25% import tax on aluminum and steel materials will remain at 25% as long as the export of the tracks takes place at the same time as the draperies.**

**Shipments of tracks in advance will be subject to a 50% tax instead of the 25%.**

**COM FABRICS STORAGE:** BWs will storage the C.O.M. fabric without any cost during 8 weeks (2 months); starting the week number 9 of storage, BWS will charge a fee of \$2.00 per roll per month.

Maximum time for fabric storage is 1 year ( fabric are imported into Mexico in a temporary manner). After 1 year, left over fabrics must be returned to USA or disposed.

BWS will not be responsible or liable for any shrinkage, discoloration, defects or other issues associated with or relating to the use of Customer's Own Materials and will only warrant workmanship as it does not apply to COM

Fabrics swatches must be submitted with purchase order identifying the corresponding product, face and direction pattern is to be applied to product. BWS will not begin production until swatches and information

Yardages are estimated based upon sizes and specifications provided. BWS will not be responsible for any additional fabrics/trims required.

Excess COM will be shipped to the property with the order upon completion of the project unless otherwise specified in writing.

**Silk Fabrics / Taffetas / Mesh fabrics and Other Specialty Fabrics :** When sewing silk fabrics and taffetas, there is a tendency for creasing/puckering which is inherent to the fabric and cannot be avoided or removed by methods such as steaming.

Mesh fabrics type are unstable as it tends to stretch and shrink; finished length of drapes using mesh fabrics can vary considerably. Page 1 of 1
